Preparing for an emergency. We've had excellent weather for ducks recently with rain, a bit more rain, followed by a slight reprieve with a truck load of rain.

Twenty years ago, a similar thing happened – but the rain kept pouring until the rivers broke their banks, the lake flooded and locals could kayak down the Mall. Though it was devastating back then, I'd hate to think what it might be like if a similar thing happened now. In 1999, the Queenstown Lakes population (including Wanaka) was around 17,000, now this figure is around 39,000. This doesn't include the three million annual visitors, many of whom would probably find being in an unfamiliar town (for some, with an unfamiliar language) during an emergency scary and confusing.

For residents, it's best to be prepared. Climate change is happening and scientists have predicted more significant weather events from dramatic storms to dramatic droughts. Thinking about the bushfires in Australia to the monster hailstorm of Timaru, it's safest to say we should expect the unexpected.

Add to all of this the fact that we're sitting near the Alpine Fault – a 600km fault line which runs up the spine of the South Island. It's ruptured four times in the past 900 years and is overdue for another – it's not a question of if, but when. Tsunamis, landslides and the destruction of major roads are all realistic scenarios.

All of this is hard to imagine when the sun is shining and the lake is just a wee bit higher than normal. Thinking about what could happen isn't about scaremongering or doom-and-gloom scenarios. It's about taking a few minutes to ensure that if you're in town when something happens, you're prepared.

So, if you're here for a few months, or have been around a few decades, take some time this week to make sure your emergency kit; a) exists, b) has everything you'll need, c) isn't full of out of date or mouldy food (yucky food is the last thing you'll want to nibble on during an emergency).

The government recommends having supplies for at least three days – this should include food and water for all the family including pets, as well as the means to cook the food (a primus or gas camping stove). A radio and a torch with spare batteries are essential as are sleeping bags, a first aid kit (with your essential medications), and wind and waterproof clothing. You'll also need some large bin bags to serve as an emergency toilet – don't expect your loo to flush after an earthquake nor should you rely on your mobile phone to work, as per the Spark outage a couple of weeks ago.

There's a handy Home Emergency Checklist available at govt.nz, take a few minutes to make sure you have everything you need.

Recently, I had an early Christmas, hosting my wider-family at my home here in Queenstown.

Here in Queenstown, the holiday period brings with it one of the busiest times of the year.

A massive thank you to all of you working in the emergency services, hospitality, public transport, retail and other sectors which keep the town going through this period.

I hope you too manage a break at some stage.

As 2019 comes to an end it has been a year full of achievements.

I would like to thank you all for your ongoing support this year and for sharing your highs and lows with me.

I have assisted more than 500 constituent cases in my Queenstown office this year.

Every case is unique and I've done all I can to get the best result for each of you.

We've had some great successes in some cases – immigration proves to be one of the biggest issues here in Queenstown.

However, it is cases like that of Juliana Costa which make my job as your MP incredibly worthwhile.

Like many people who make Queenstown their home, Juliana contributes immensely to our community and I'm thrilled we succeeded in getting her two-year open work visa.

The bigger problem is visa processing times, as 13 out of the 14 major visa category visa applications are still taking longer to be processed than under the previous National-led government.

I want to assure you I continue to lobby for better services here in Queenstown.

This year also brought with it the Parliamentary Rugby Team, as I hosted a match between them and the late Blair Vining's invitational team here in April.

We managed to raise almost \$15,000 for Garston School for their new school bus seat belts and the Blair Vining Sports Foundation.

We lost Blair recently, and while he may be gone, his legacy in achieving better cancer care for all New Zealanders will live on.

It was incredible to see so much wonderful support for this event – a massive thank you again to all of you who got on board.

My private member's bill became law this year, putting foster children on an even playing field, as any foster parent (or kin carer) can approach a KiwiSaver provider to open a KiwiSaver account for a foster child in their care.

We also secured a new independent hospital here in Queenstown, which I had been advocating for since first elected, and also opened a new emergency department at the current hospital.

I'm also still urging for rezoning in the accommodation supplement space.

We've had many smiles and plenty of good news in 2019 and I already can't wait to see what 2020 delivers.

Again, happy holidays and I can't wait to work with you and for you in 2020.

AirBnB is killing this town

I know, I know, you're a homeowner and you're entitled to do what you want with said home. And in most municipalities that is an entirely fair statement.

What isn't fair is the proliferation of AirBnB listings, and the flouting of local legislation regarding the volume said listing is allowed to be, well, listed. On a per capita basis, we have some of the highest quantities of AirBnB's listed, coupled with the highest quantities of entire houses listed. It is this situation that results in, significantly higher rental prices, and significantly higher housing prices, based off the higher yield the seller can show.

We have a finite number of dwellings available for the significant number in the working population, who are being readily displaced because the average homeowner can get a higher return from listing their house as a holiday let. Now I know local government has implemented rules regarding nightly volumes, but without a watchdog in place to actually enforce this, what is actually stopping anyone? I personally know many people who aren't abiding by these rules, and have been doing so for years. So now you've got a working population that has to pay higher rental prices, because those who haven't holiday-let their dwellings can increase rental expectation of the supply and demand situation that is left in the rental pool available. This also impacts local businesses, who either cannot find staff - as people simply don't want to pay the living costs (see all the job vacancy listings for proof) - or

they have to add higher wages/training to ever increasing costs, that don't necessarily couple with ever-increasing revenue. Finally you've got the houses themselves that consistently rank as the most expensive in the country. This is in part because the yield has been increased, so instead of a reasonable return on investment, some are netting obscene amounts - I've personally heard of return so high on an average dwelling that they should really be listed for GST. But really, no one is doing anything 'wrong', because they have all been technically allowed to do so. So in the end it's not actually AirBnB hosts or the service itself that is the issue, it's the local government and their apparent willingness to sit ideally by while it all happens. Maybe we did need AirBnB a few years ago because we were apparently terrified of being branded as 'full', but now that hotel developments have just about caught up, and visitor numbers have stabilized, is it not time to address this? We need to invest in our local economy by realising the significant social issues being exacerbated on a 'make hay while the sun shines' philosophy, and a quick fix for the mean time would be a crack-down on listing volumes and nights allowed. This would let rental prices exceed or match the return from holiday letting, and bring the market back to order. 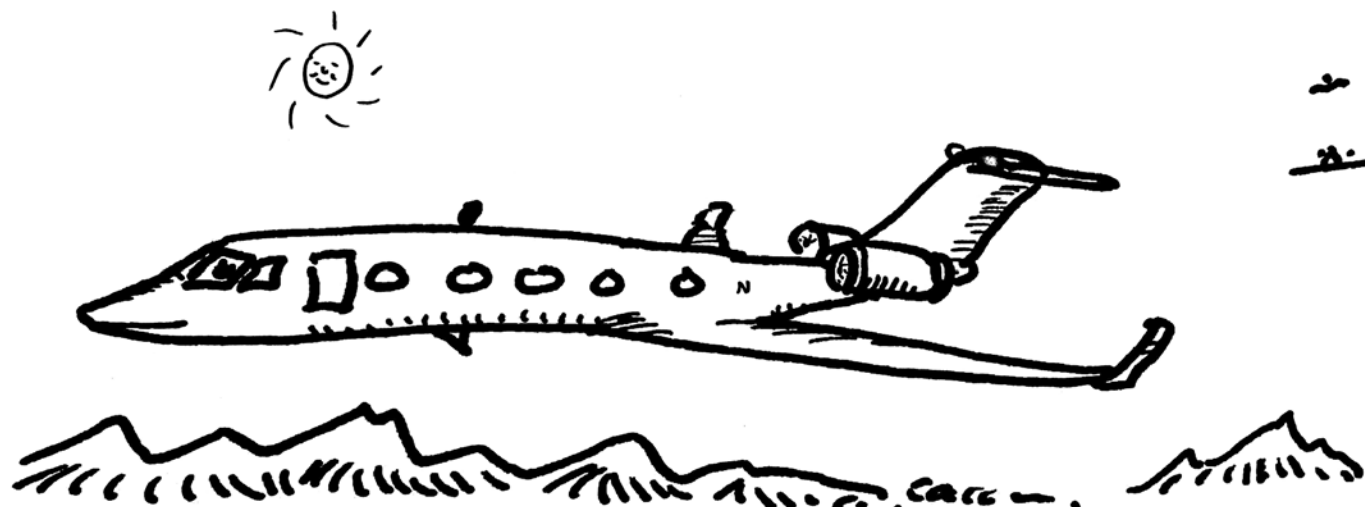

Queenstown Lakes District Council meeting

Public Forum on 12th December 2019

From Lime e-scooters to 5G, democracy to climate change, the public forum at last week's council meeting was jam-packed. Mayor Jim Boulton welcomed everyone and stated that each person had three minutes to speak, in the interests of giving everyone an opportunity to have their say. Twenty-one people had registered to speak, which Mayor Boulton said "could be a record." LWB went along to see what the community had to say...

GROWING LOCAL MEDIA

First up was Peter Newport, editor and director of Crux. "I'm speaking as a journalist," he said, highlighting a 'media crisis', particularly in the regions as international giants like Facebook and Google sucked up advertising revenue and sales teams were prioritised over journalists. He suggests Council look at ways to fund media support and training programmes.

LIME E-SCOOTERS



Lime's NZ public affairs manager Lauren Mentjox started, with the South Island operations manager, Andrew Ellis, at her side. She said it would be a privilege to start a trial in Queenstown and acknowledged there had been some incidents: "There's always risks with public transport," she added. She talked about safety controls and highlighted that the e-scooters had not been banned in Auckland, "just missed

out on" a licence for six months.

Several ratepayers and community members spoke against the trial. Grey Power's Kirsty Sharpe and several others questioned Queenstown's suitability for the transport method and many raised concerns about e-scooters being dumped in the lake. Local resident Nicky Tompkins made a few people laugh with her comments about Lime's assurances that the scooters were safe was a bit like the tobacco industry saying vaping was good for your health.

"QLDC has the advantage of learning from others," said Julie Williamson, who's been a local ratepayer for 46 years, "We need to ask, does it meet [ratepayers] needs?"

Greg Miller of the Kelvin Peninsular Community Association said he'd tried and loved the scooters in other cities... but "they're not for [Queenstown]."

Chamber of Commerce CEO Anna Mickell questioned Lime's ability to staff the business, given the struggles of others in the region to find accommodation for team members. She said she'd tried e-scooters in other cities and there "are better options out there," including some e-scooter brands which may be able to tackle Queenstown's varied terrain. "Don't give up on this [...] but put it out to the market," was her message.

Council later voted to go ahead with the Lime e-scooter trial, with a delayed start date of April 2020.

CLIMATE CHANGE AND THE AIRPORT EXPANSION

Two local residents spoke about climate change. A representative from Extinction Rebellion asked that Council become active participants in slowing climate change, while another resident argued that Council looked at claims by 'climate alarmists' with scepticism.

A number of residents asked Council to carefully consider the need for growth.

Some suggested Queenstown should lead the way in reducing the number of flights for community wellbeing, therefore reduce our impact on climate change and better manage current visitor numbers. Most were in agreement that no further public surveys were needed "when the people have already said a resounding NO." One speaker said the money for public reviews – of which the results will be obvious – should instead go into a safety review.

The Queenstown Airport Corporation's revised Statement of Intent (SOI) was accepted by Council with some restrictions, plus a QLDC steering group was set up to develop the SOI.

BUILDING CODES

Local resident Michael Clark asked Council to examine the strength of the building code. He reminded the council of extreme winters past – in 1850, 1940 in Otago and of the extreme snowfall several countries in the northern hemisphere are experiencing this year. He also added that if the recent storms had happened in winter, local buildings would need to withstand a lot of snowfall.

5G

5G was another hot topic at the meeting. Nelson lawyer Sue Grey said that "5G is a matter that nobody knows much about," and went on to stress that more scientific research should be done before it's rolled out. She also suggested that not everyone needs the download speeds 5G enables, so perhaps those who did need it could access it in certain places, but the technology should not be rolled out everywhere.

Wayne Foley, who said he'd sponsored Sue to visit Queenstown, suggested that the council puts together a sub-committee, to show that they are "asking questions" on the topic. Georgia Todd and Sheree Horomona talked about the impact 5G could have on families. Georgia said she was "a lack of health and safety at its most basic," while Sheree spoke of the effect her family and pets were already feeling from the eleven towers near her home in Frankton.

Jim Boulton finished the discussion by stressing that the "only input [Council] have is resource consent [...] but we will take it on board."

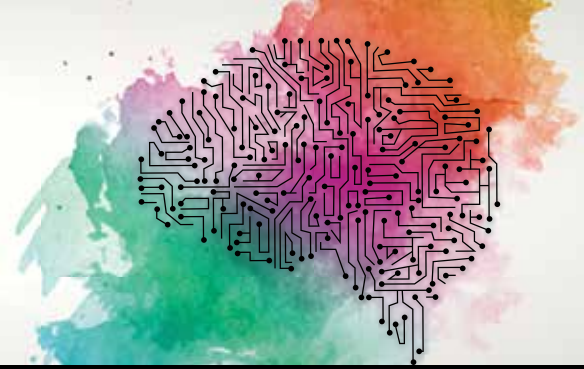

Christmas Mince, Sugar Plum Pies

A Ballerina's insight into The Remarkable Men's Ballet.

Local councillor and radio announcer, Craig 'Ferg' Ferguson, has been a regular dancer for the popular men's troupe. He's clocked in (roughly) 12 years.

"They nicked named me 'G', the general. I guess it's to do with longevity."

Their 2 minute set has always been a crowd favourite at the annual Queenstown Christmas Show.

"Jaw's drop. 'Ohhh the men's ballet!'"

The attraction to join the troupe stemmed from Ferguson's household dance activities.

"I have 2 daughters, 24 and 21 now, and they were very good dancers in their younger days. My wife was from a dancing background. I guess the girls have always got their dancing abilities from their mother, but I just wanted to prove to them that actually, it could've been from Dad."

The group of 10 dancers allocate five weeks to squeeze in 8 rehearsals and a Friday Flash Mob before the big show.

Anna Stuart, choreographs and directs the men.

"Some of the steps are proving a bit of a handful." says Ferg.

They've all signed up to a private Whatsapp group. Rehearsals are videoed and uploaded for them to practice at home.

"It's a pretty slick operation if you can't make the rehearsal." he adds.

The group has gotten so popular that they've performed outside of the Christmas realms. At Winter festival they staged a Lion King performance and last year a belly dancing troupe was formed for the Arrowtown Autumn Festival.

The commradery and enthusiasm among the mix of local 'mincers' is undoubtedly strong.

"You'll hear someone go 'Mince, Mince, Mince' and that means you gotta get your face on, don't forget your face."

But the troupe seems to suffer from members coming and going.

"This year we've lost 4..."

One massive loss being the absence of local farmer Chris Dagg, who's been dancing from it's inception.

"They've divided us into two groups The Sugar Plum Fairies (the newbies) and the Plum fairies (which are all the oldies)."

Both groups are rallying to get donations for a local charity, Baby box, which provides parents with a box of essentials needed for their newborn.

"For me, and as it is for a lot of the other mincers, it's about the community. I'm not comfortable getting up there, but you do it because of what it is, it's a Christmas Show."

The Remarkables Men Ballet will have performed at the Christmas Show on Sunday 15th of December. Ferg provided us with this review.

"A stunning, technical performance that will probably revival Tour Benildean - Which means we're not gonna be anything like that."

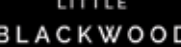

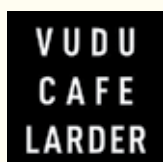
