Is Queenstown still the welcoming place it once was?

For a community that can be so generous and considerate, it's discouraging to see the plethora of comments on Queenstown Trading with veiled racism and xenophobia, after the last few week's road accidents.

As a second-generation immigrant to Canada, I grew up in the vast pool of multiculturalism that was the Greater Toronto Area. When I left, I had hoped to find a place that would make me feel just as welcome. Queenstown had been the answer for the last five years however recently, I'm not so sure.

The negativity being hurled at "foreigners" on Facebook is disgusting, and it is disheartening to see the amount of support for some of these sentiments.

When people leave comments such as "Tourists from 3rd world countries...", "...Foreign F***tards" or "Another CHINESE OPERATED BUS" on a public Queenstown forum, I have no choice but to second guess who I thought my kind neighbours were.

Has this place I've chosen to live not actually been all that accepting of me? Perhaps the praise I've given to friends and family about the kindness of Queenstown locals was a misjudgement.

It should not be okay to share racially insensitive Youtube videos on a Queenstown community page in jest. What message does this send to those from other countries who have just recently settled here?

On the post regarding last week's bus incident, where is the concern for the 20 people injured? Had this been a bus full of locals, would the comments have read differently? Would we still be demanding to see the bus driver's licence? Who counts as foreigners?

I understand the frustrations towards the amount of accidents on the roads. I do not however, understand the shameful manner in which people have set out on a "us" vs "them" parade, making those from Asian decent living in Queenstown feel inferior and uncomfortable in a place that they have chosen live. Look around you. Queenstown is full of "foreigners" from all over the world. People come here with stories of their own, meet and discover new cultures, develop new ways of thinking, learn things, indulge in food, art and community.

Plastering hate speech – and yes, I do refer to it as hate speech – all over a community forum does nothing but make people feel excluded and outcasted.

It doesn't matter that these comments are directed towards tourists. The words are there, the words are hurtful, and they speak volumes against the ethnicities in which they attack.

A sad feeling to have after having been enamoured with a place I was so eager to call home.

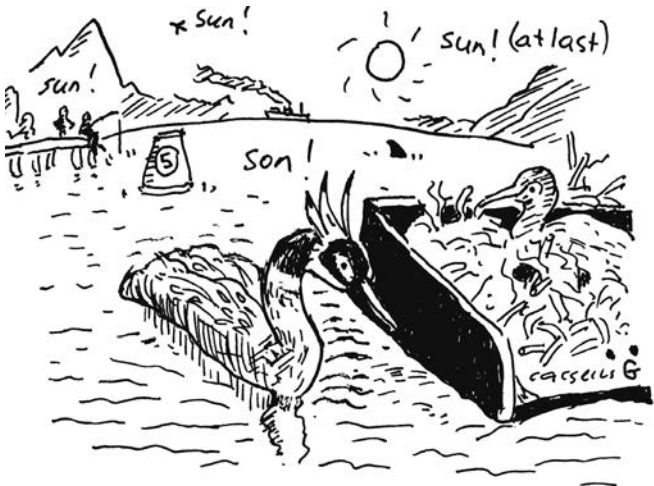
"Thanks so much, but let one of the oldies have it", I said and moved off. I had completely forgotten I AM one of the oldies.

Wondering how to safely dispose of batteries?

Our first tip...never put them in your rubbish or recycling wheelie bin! Batteries can be damaged during the collection process which can cause them to combust. This is particularly the case for Lithium ion batteries such as those in cell phones, laptops, power tools, e-bike batteries and other rechargeable items. You can tell if it's a lithium ion battery because it's normally marked Li-ion. Many types of batteries can be dropped off for recycling at the Wakatipu Recycling Centre and Wastebusters. For Brendan Mulcahy of Kingston, putting on a party was a social hobby as well as a charity service. Dedicating time and more often than not, his own money, to make an event come together.

After continued practice and positive re-enforcement from his friends Brendan took a leap into the unknown, to throw a party for everyone with the heartfelt aim of raising money to support others. He knew Queenstown could generate money and was aware of families and individuals in need and struggling for support.

Its a day which draws a crowd to Kingston with the heartfelt vibe of partying for a good cause. They've even opted to be environmental conscious by making this event 'glass free'.

To continue the progressing the festival needs 2000 tickets sold this year. With only a handful of helpers, Brendan has called out to the public for their support



Q. I hear that the salary/wage levels have increased for work and residence visas. What are the new levels?

A. Once a year (typically in November), Immigration New Zealand reviews the remuneration thresholds for the Skilled Migrant Category Residence and the Essential Skills Work Visa categories. Last year was no different and from 24 February 2020, the following new levels will come into effect:

For work visas under the Essential Skills Category:

- For Higher skilled visas – up to 5 years' visa duration – \$38.25+ per hour (or equivalent annual salary), regardless of the ANZSCO classification of the position of employment; or
- For Mid-skilled visas – up to 3 years' visa duration – \$21.68 to \$38.24 per hour (or equivalent annual salary), where the position of employment is classified as ANZSCO skill level 1, 2 or 3; or
- For Lower-skilled visas – up to 12 months visa duration – less than \$21.67 per hour (or equivalent annual salary) where the position of employment is classified as ANZSCO skill level 1, 2 or 3; or less than \$38.24 per hour (or equivalent annual salary) where the position of employment is classified as ANZSCO skill level 4 or 5.
- Some occupations at ANZSCO skill levels 4 and 5 are treated as an exception. From 24 February 2020 the threshold for skilled employment for these occupations will be NZD \$25.50+ per hour.

For resident visas under the Skilled Migrant Category:

- For occupations classified as ANZSCO skill level 1, 2 or 3 – \$25.50+ per hour (or equivalent annual salary).
- For occupations classified as ANZSCO skill level 4 or 5 – \$38.25+ per hour (or equivalent annual salary).
- For occupations not included in the ANZSCO – \$38.25+ per hour (or equivalent annual salary).
- Bonus points for high remuneration – \$51+ per hour (or equivalent annual salary).
- Some occupations at ANZSCO skill levels 4 and 5 are treated as an exception and can be mid-skilled. From 24 February 2020 the threshold for mid-skilled employment for these occupations will be NZD \$25.50+ per hour.

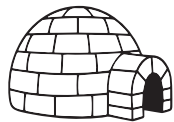

War on wildings deserves more funding

As Finance Minister Grant Robertson ponders what to put in his Budget in May, understandably his mind – and those of his fellow Cabinet ministers – will be on the election later in the year. It's not an issue that necessarily captures voters' attention, but let's hope they remember to allocate some extra millions to a scourge on the land that has severe environmental and economic impacts – wilding pines.

Wilding pines are trees that have self-seeded from wind-blown cones from plantation forests and shelter belts. The NZ Wilding Conifer Group, on which Federated Farmers is represented, estimates that wilding pines affect at least 1.8 million hectares – almost 6% of NZ's land area. They spread fast; left unmanaged it has been estimated that within 30 years they would cover more than a quarter of our landscape.

Wilding pines take the sunshine, water and nutrients other plants need to grow and then quickly become the dominant species. Land that is adversely affected by wilding pines includes farmland, recreational land, sites of cultural and historical importance, as well as New Zealand's unique natural environment. Wilding pines can irreversibly change some of our threatened and rare ecosystems, meaning that once an area is invaded by wilding pines, it can be difficult to return it to its original state.

If you're not moved by the environmental arguments, consider the fiscal impacts. Wilding pines can decrease the amount of water that flows into rivers by 30% to 40%. They use so

much water they are a significant threat to irrigation and hydro-electricity generation. A recent cost-benefit analysis found that if left unmanaged, wilding pines will cost us \$739 million by 2050 just in losses in productive land, and another nearly \$3 billion from losses in irrigation and hydroelectricity potential.

Fortunately, we are fighting back against this 'wrong tree in the wrong place'. A programme led by Biosecurity New Zealand, working with the Department of Conservation and Land Information New Zealand, spent \$16 million between 2016 and 2019 to control wilding pines on 1.5m hectares of some of our most vulnerable iconic landscapes. The NZ Wilding Conifer Group has warned that if this work is not followed up to remove remaining wildings before they mature to seed production age, the money spent to date may be wasted and the opportunity for wilding extermination missed.

Kudos to the Government. It awarded an extra \$10.5m for each of 2019 and 2020 for the national wilding control programme.

As Federated Farmers said at the time of the Budget 2019 announcement – that's very welcome but it's not enough. To win the wildings battle, the war chest needs to be more like \$25 million a year and not limited to two years.

By some estimates, it's a \$250 million problem growing at 20 per cent per year.

DOC research shows that expenditure on wilding pine control is very cost effective. This is because wilding pines do not produce cones until they are very visible, allowing detection and removal before further spread is initiated.

Also, wilding pine seed does not last more than a few years in the soil, so there is no long-lasting seed bank which can germinate and cause reinvasion many years after control is undertaken.

Work is underway by forestry companies on planting buffer trees with a low seed spread risk. There is also debate on the potential use of gene-editing to ensure the plantation trees we plant for wood production are sterile and don't spread.

Doing the control work on wilding pines now is an investment in the future. The NZ Wilding Conifer Group has calculated that increasing funding for wilding conifer control to \$118 million over four years will result in a net benefit of \$6.1 billion. The ratio of benefit to cost for this level of investment is 38:1.

They're surely some numbers that should make the eyes of a Finance Minister light up.

The popular snow sports, music and après ski extravaganza is heading to Cardrona this September. It's held annually in Avoriaz, France and this is the festival's first foray into the Southern Hemisphere. In 2018, it was announced Snowboxx would be hosted the following year by Queenstown's Coronet Peak and the Remarkables ski areas. But the dates of the 2019 festival clashed with Winter Pride and organisers say there simply wasn't enough accommodation in the resort town to host both festivals at the same time.

Now the festival's set to move over the hill, this time clashing (nicely) with Cardrona's 40th birthday celebrations and the extension of the ski area's offering with the acquisition of Treble Cone late last year.

The festival will also have a little local help this time – with Wanaka-based Rhythm and Alps festival organiser Alex Turnbull on board as a shareholder and director of the New Zealand edition of Snowboxx. Alex says he went along to the French version in March 2019, to get a feel for the festival.

"It's a really good offering. But we want to do something different here. The landscape is our point of difference."

He adds that Cardrona-raised snow sports star Jossi Wells, who runs the annual Jossi Wells Invitational snow sports event, will also have a hand in the festival.

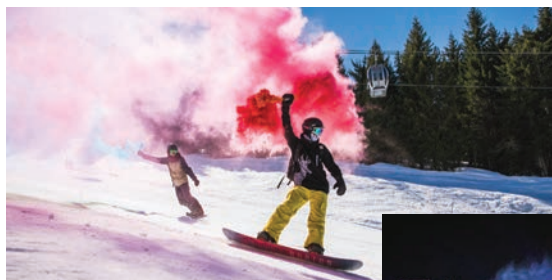
"We have four really strong brands working together. The event will be spread over one week and there'll be a purpose-built event stage at Cardrona's learners' area. There'll be après ski events and we're looking at doing satellite events across the region (we may look at some in Queenstown and just this morning we were discussing the possibility of a comedy event). The details are still to be determined, but I think we'll have a good idea of the line up in about a month."

Previous events have featured the likes of Fatboy Slim, Basement Jaxx and Stormzy – the festival's reputation clearly precedes it as Alex says there's already been 7,000 registrations of interest so far.

Packages include seven nights of accommodation in Wanaka and a festival wristband, starting at \$440 per person.

"It's going to be great, not just for the region, but for New Zealand. It's a strong offering at a quieter time of year."

Major survey launched to gauge workforce shortages in the region.

For many businesses finding, training and retaining staff is their largest ongoing business issue. Workforce under employment is so pervasive across the Queenstown, Wanaka and Central regions that many sectors struggle to operate efficiently especially in the key holiday times. For some that means limiting the hours of operation or what services or products are available and for new business in the region it can be particularly problematic, leading to a delayed opening or staggered launch as owners and management completely underestimate the time it takes to find staff, get them onboard, to even open the doors.

At the Lakes Weekly Bulletin and JobFix we hear about the struggle companies have in finding staff regularly, however there is shortage of hard data on the issues facing business in the region, that can help inform the planning process. Understaffing prevents businesses from reaching their potential and stifles growth in the region.

JobFix, The Central App and Wanaka App along with the Queenstown Chamber of Commerce and Ignite Wanaka are working together, with the support of the Economic Development division at QLDC to call on all businesses to fill in a business survey that aims to fill in the gap in community knowledge around under employment and its economic impact.



Based on the feedback received, the stakeholders in the survey, aim to stimulate labour force planning and action, that while it won't cure under employment it will certainly provide a data base across all parts of the region that will help business, council and chambers tactically improve how the region responds to what is one of the area's largest business headaches.

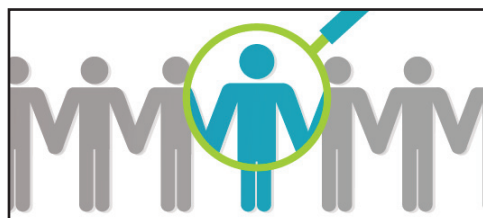
