January - what a month

Last week was a week of nonstop sirens and Queenstown was making the news for reasons not normally associated with our resort town. Being in the middle of town, it seemed as if emergency services vehicles were travelling back and forwards through the CBD, trying to be everywhere at once. On Thursday afternoon, incidents occurred in Arrowtown, Gibbston Valley and Glenorchy Road.

January must have been trying and difficult month for first responders as our police, fire brigade and ambulance services would have been stretched to the max and individuals on the front line experienced sights that no one wants to witness, let alone with the frequency January brought.

The tail end of 2019 brought the threat of, or in Wanaka's case, actual flooding. Then, on the 1st January we woke up to bushfire smoke from Australia and since then, the region has been inundated with incidents from wind events and fire to fatal accidents. It's certainly been a strange start to the year.

With each one of these events the emergency services have been needed and they have delivered. We generally take our emergency services teams for granted and some like to take pot shots at the job they do on a day to day basis, until the time comes where we need them in an emergency and then they are the most important individuals and organisations in the world and they deliver with professionalism, compassion and expertise.

I am clearly not alone in this feeling that January has been a difficult start, judging by the Mayor Boulton's comments made in a release on road safety earlier in the week.

Our first responders are extraordinary people who are doing the job because of the passion they have for making a difference in our community. I take my hat off to them and I certainly know that dealing with what they are exposed to is something I could not do regularly without it impacting me mentally. Whether volunteers or full-time professionals, it's an important and difficult job. These individuals, whose aim is to protect property and life, are extraordinarily dedicated and committed and I would like to thank all our emergency services personnel for the tremendous contribution in protecting our community. The work you do often goes unnoticed and sometimes under appreciated but as January closes, summer crowds start to lessen and perhaps February will be calmer, I certainly want to take the opportunity to say thank you, once again.

Top comedy competition comes to Otago

One of Aotearoa's top amateur comedy competitions is coming to Otago for the first time this February and March.

The Raw Comedy Quest has been running for 20 years, but Otago-based comedians previously had to enter events in Canterbury or further afield. Last year, local comedy group Remarkably Funny held a satellite heat as part of the Canterbury-based competition. This year, they've teamed up with the Dunedin Comedy group to run seven Otago-based shows as part of the national competition. The Otago champion will win a trip to Auckland for the national finals, to be held as a component of the NZ International Comedy Festival in May.

Remarkably Funny's Tim Müller says that considering Dunedin's and the Southern Lakes' thriving stand up scenes, "the time is right for a stand-alone Otago competition."

"It's a right of passage for comedians. It's not the only pathway to success of course, but if you've got talent and drive it can be a leg up.

"There's three loose categories that the judges are looking for; how well written the material is; stage presence; and the 'general 'funny factor'. This last one is hard to articulate, it's about how well the comedian connects with the audience, an X-factor... it's hard to describe but you know it when you see it."

The regional finals will be held in Dunedin on 28th March and there'll be heats in Queenstown (4th February, Yonder) and Wanaka (13th February, Mint Bar). The Southern Lakes semi-finals will be held in Queenstown on 3rd March.

Tim adds that it's a great opportunity for comedians – aspiring or experienced – to "face their fears".

"It's open for comedians who've been doing stand up for up to three years, but we're very open to first-timers down here. We want to grow the local scene as much as possible."

"What makes a competition like this so exciting to watch is that, with all the acts relatively new to comedy, absolutely anything could happen. There are a lot of talented performers entering after a year or two of honing their craft, but there's also every chance someone could step on stage for the first time and blow the audience (and the judges) away."

The competition is open to anyone who is a New Zealand resident or citizen and audiences are invited to watch.

Dolly Parton's America

You don't have to be a Dolly Parton fan to get sucked into this podcast. Dolly Parton's America is a nine-part podcast by WNYC and while it is the story of Dolly Parton, it's also the story of America and especially women.

Dolly started what she calls her "sad ass songs" period telling stories from her childhood, growing up at the foot of the Smokey Mountains. She had a knack for writing what's known as 'murder ballads' – a form that was traditionally sung by men and details the murder of women. Dolly subverted this, singing from the victim's perspective and filling in a viewpoint which, at the time, was seldom heard (think songs like 'The Bridge' and 'Coming Down from Dover').


The podcast looks at Dolly's influence and why she's now considered part of the third phase of feminism, an icon and a role model. Each episode is an hour long and – even if you're not a Dolly Parton fan – you'll find it fascinating.

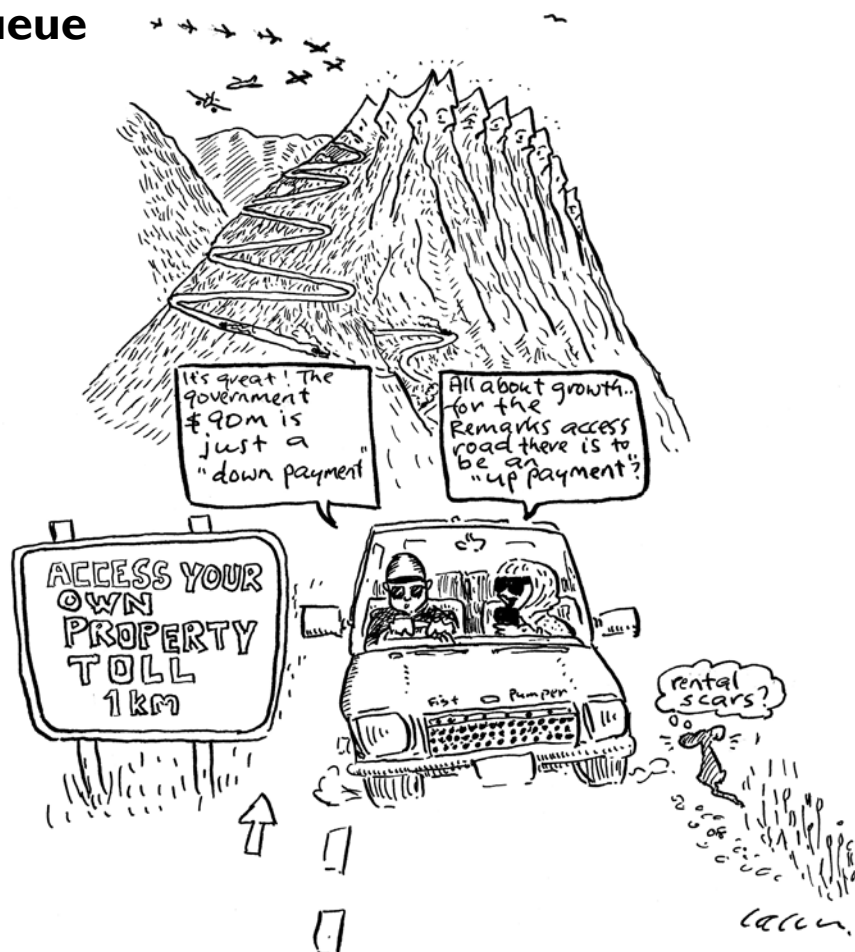

Queenstown Lakes District Council meeting

Public Forum on 30th January 2020

The meeting started with Maori youth, Connor Horn being awarded with a certificate of recognition for his participation in the Tuia Programme. Connor said "The Tuia programme, has been truly eye opening. Growing up in Queenstown in a Pakeha environment I was never really exposed to any maori heritage." The yearlong Tuia programme involves the commitment of both rangatahi and mayor.



Climate Action plan

Pierre Marasti spoke on behalf of Extinction Rebellion Queenstown-Lakes. He expressed his feelings the Celebrating NYE with fireworks while Australia is burning away, 'just felt obscene.' "Climate Action Plan, you can make a difference". Pierre has pledged to attend every public forum as a passage of protest.

Monique Kelly from One Summit Wanaka implored council to bring in the experts and engage further with the community on the Climate Action Plan. The second stage of the plan is to be discussed during 'public closed' session of the council meeting and she questioned this process. "Not setting an ambitious target is a violation of Human Rights."

"We need to have experts around the table" calling on council to involve other entities in the drafting of this plan and to not keep the responsibility in house. These points were followed up by Dr Carly Green, another member of One Summit who pointed out that NZ is the 4th worst polluter in the world with individual kiwis accumulating waste equaling 18 tonnes per year compared with the 16 tonnes a US individual produces.

Daryl Rogers recited a 100-year-old poem and recalled his life in Australia and the environment's natural processes "Fire doesn't kill forests, it creates life." His message linked to actioning climate change. "The house has always been on fire."

Enviroschools

Robyn Zink praised the councils ongoing support for the Enviroschools initiative with 12 schools in the district on board with the programme. "...the longer the school is involved with the programme the more immediate their sustainability practices become." "Our biggest area of demand is the early childhood sector, which we cannot cover at the moment." Enviroschools works with 3 early childhood centers in Wanaka, currently funded by Wastebusters, along with the high school, with council funding the regions primary schools. While recognizing council support, she hinted at the need for further funding in to the ECE area.

5G

"Last Saturday marked the international day of protest against 5G" said local Halt 5G representative, Georgia Todd. In the last public forum of 2019, Nelson Lawyer Sue Gray consulted council on safer policies around the teleco network. "We were promised a workshop..." Georgia heard the workshop has already taken place as a component of a number of other community issues and 5G was not addressed as a 'standalone matter'. Georgia felt the promise of a workshop has not been honored and presented a petition to halt 5G in the Queenstown & Arrowtown area.

Other Council news

- Lime scooters start date was confirmed for April.
- Lots of discussions around new dog bylaws including the closure of Queenstown Hill for dogs and ideas were put forward for a dog friendly zone at Ladies Mile.

Police the roads

The major problem with driving here is the total lack of policing the road rules, both for locals and tourists. The Police just do not police the rules. Example:- Every day when I ride my bike to work, I see at least 8 people texting or on their phones while driving. You see it all day long. People driving down Shotover St all using their phones NOTHING is ever done about it. Example:- people (mostly locals) running red lights. Yesterday I was sitting on a red light in Ballarat St / Stanley St. The Stanley St traffic had the green light, it turned orange, and a local tour company bus was approx 45 metres from the intersection. intersection, the green pedestrian light came on - this sort of thing happens countless times each and every day. Again, NOBODY polices it. Example:- Not stopping at STOP signs at intersections. It is the norm here to slow up and coast through STOP signs. Again, I see it each and every day the Police do nothing about it. Example:- Failing to indicate. This town would be one of the worst places on planet earth for drivers failing to indicate (and again, I'm talking about locals). What needs to happen here is for the police to actually POLICE the rules. They spend 99 percent of the time looking for drunk drivers and speedsters. They need to put a bit of effort into the basics as well or get someone else to do the basics for them.

There's no point in having road rules if nobody polices them.

I have the opposite perspective to the writer, we "freedom camp". New Zealand Citizens, have a certified CSC motorhome and also belong to a club and pay fees. We also often pick up rubbish left by others at camp spots. The only time I have caught someone defecation it was a local in a car. "Camping" happened long before there were any more organized Council designated, paid Camps. Paid camps came about because some people worked out that they could make money out of it. Valentine's Day wasn't always such a day about love.

Valentines Day, currently a cuddly, kissy and commercialized day but if you unwrap the 21-century packaging and dig deeper into it's past, you'll find that Phwoah! It has a dark past.

No one has pinpointed the exact origin of the festival, but a good place to start is ancient Rome.

Roman Romantics celebrated the feast of Lupercalia from February 13 to 15. This is a time where men hit on women, by hitting them.

They'd slaughter and skin an animal then whipped the women with the bloody hides. Ladies willingly lined up for this gruesome spanking. They believed this would make them fertile.

The festival included a match making lottery. Couples were drawn out of the jar and would spend the majority of the festival together, if not longer - if all went well.

Ancient Romans also tied Valentine's day to Emperor Claudius II executions of two men, both who were named Valentine. This was held on the 14 of Feb, but in different years of the 3rd century A.D. The Catholic Church honoured their martyrdom by calling for the celebration of St Valentine.

Roll forward a few centuries

Late in the 5th century Pope Gelasius I meddled with the day by combining the feast of Lupercalia with the execution Valentine. He wanted the day to be less raucous, to cover up the wife whipping and animal skinning rituals, and for Christians to focus on celebrating fertility and love.

Shakespeare created the romantic version we know today

Shakespeare the grand wordsmith came along and romanticized the day in his works. Shakespeare mentions Saint Valentine's Day in A Midsummer Night's Dream and in Hamlet, where he alludes to the superstition that if two single people meet on the morning of Saint Valentine's Day they will likely get married. February 14th is the day because in the fourteenth-century Europe believed that on February 14, birds begin to mate.

It gained popularity through Britain, then Europe. People made paper cards especially on the day. This little running tradition got amplified in the 19th century, thanks to the Industrial Revolution. 1913, Hallmark Cards of Kansas City, Mo., began mass producing valentines. February has not been the same since.

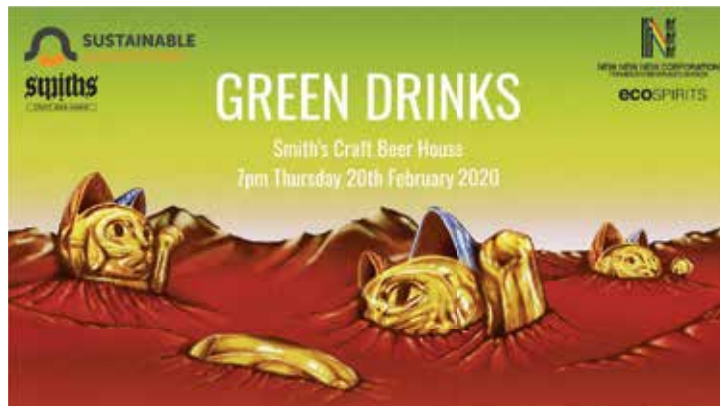

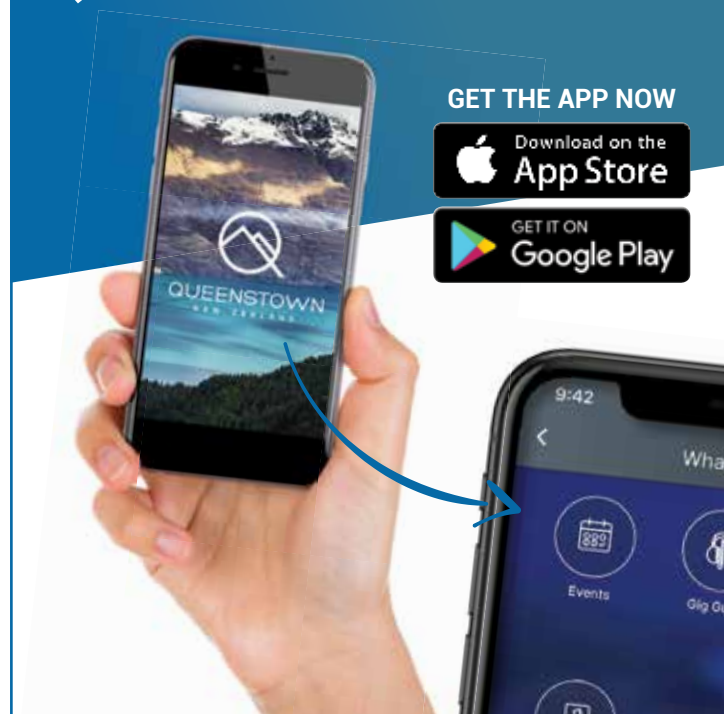

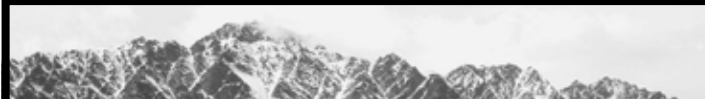

Monster Weekend of Speedway

Friday and Saturday at Heavy Trax Hire Central Motor Speedway off Highway 6 in Cromwell's Sandflat Road really is a monster weekend with Super Saloons, aka Monsters of Speedway, featuring loud, proud and fast.

Friday sees these low, wide purebred racecars with 700 to 800 horsepower V8's lurking under their bonnets compete in round four of the hotly contested 2019 – 220 Mag & Turbo Super Cup.

Then on Saturday a good few of the Mag & Turbo competitors plus others will be scorching the clay to decide the 2019 – 20 season South Island Super Saloon Champion.

Such is the calibre of entries any of 15 drivers have a chance of snatching the title, including Central Motor Speedway's Ray Stewart (34t) who is just a couple of weeks shy of turning 70, ever improving Wakatipu basin-based Greig Johnston (77t) and seasoned competitor Owen Dixon (95d). But to be realistic the 't' drivers are up against some class acts including the man they call 'The Baby Faced Assassin' current 3NZ Ian Burson and also Richie Taylor (58c) who has been 2NZ three times.

As well as super saloons, productions are a big part of both Friday and Saturday with some 60 drivers of these surprisingly quick stripped out road cars descending on Central Otago to compete in the Friend Forestry 2019 – 20 New Zealand Productions Championship. Here again drivers with the Central Motor Speedway 't' after their numbers are in with a chance of winning the title, notably Whetu Taewa (616t) who over recent seasons has been successfully mixing productions and sprint car racing, Geoff Friend (11t) and Ron Koole (21t).

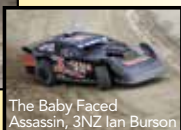
An optimistic sight for the future of speedway is an entry list of 26 ministocks driven 12 to 16 year olds. Many of these will likely progress to classes such as six shooters (wingless sprint cars) where former youth ministocker Adam Evans (41t) recently won the 2020 Southland Six Shooter Championship. On the subject of sprint cars, speedway's fastest class will be racing over the weekend.

VACANCIES

Open roles spiked in December but overall 2019 was an average year!

Summary

- The jobs market was particularly competitive for the first three weeks of December before slowing in the lead into Christmas.
- Unusually December was up 8% on November this year whereas traditionally December is slower and the first month of the shoulder season.
- The Construction sector was a big mover, driving the market higher as several projects got underway ahead of the holiday period. The number of construction positions available rose 20% over November.
- The rolling six months JobFix index showed an increase of 5% over the same period 2018 and 2% over 2017.

While local businesses struggled to find staff toward the end of 2019 a result of many companies waiting until right on the holiday period before looking for staff, the last six months of 2019 was actually an average year. The last six months increased 5% on 2018 and 2% on 2017. The jobs market remained extremely tight especially in December, however the peak period for the year seems to have been reached in October and is now slowly easing off.

Many businesses waited until December to look for holiday staff rather than going out early in November.

This was partly weather related as local owners dealt with the potential flooding and an unseasonably cool start to summer, which led to softer business confidence. The first 3 weeks of December saw record open positions being advertised with an average of 265 roles being advertised according to the latest JobFix data before dropping back to 180 in the week leading into Christmas.

January is expected to remain strong before demand dips heading into the shoulder season. Historically Feb-May forms the shoulder season with June through August the quieter time.

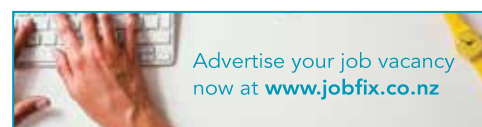

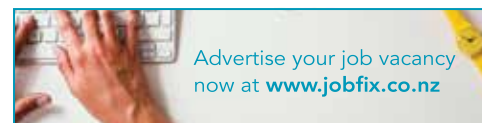

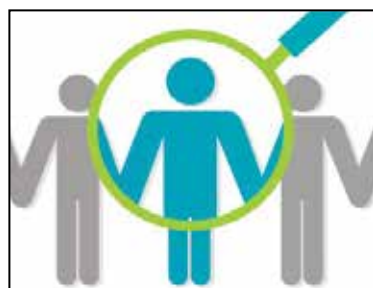
